

## Standard Sector Indicator Reference Sheet

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### INDICATOR: Number of individual adolescent girls and young women (AGYW) (10–24 years) enrolled in DREAMS who have completed at least the DREAMS primary package of services/interventions at the time of reporting

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#### Disaggregation:

- AGYW enrolled in DREAMS who have fully completed at least one DREAMS service/ intervention but *not* the full primary package of services/interventions
- AGYW enrolled in DREAMS who have fully completed the entire DREAMS primary package of services/interventions but have not received any services/interventions beyond the primary package
- AGYW enrolled in DREAMS who have fully completed the primary package of services/interventions *and* at least one secondary or contextual service/intervention

Each of the above is further disaggregated by:

- **Time in DREAMS:** 0–3 month(s), 4–6 months, 7–9 months, 10–12 months, 12–24 months, 25+ months
- **Age:** 10–14F, 15–19F, 20–24F, 25–29F

#### Related Objectives:

- Increase the knowledge and skills of vulnerable youth to remain HIV-free (Objective 1.1)
- Increase the knowledge and skills of people living with or affected by HIV/AIDS, including OVC and their families, to improve their well-being and resilience (Objective 2.1)

#### Precise definitions

**Adolescent girls and young women (AGYW):** females 10–24 years old.

**Enrolled in DREAMS:** DREAMS is an ambitious partnership to reduce HIV infections among adolescent girls and young women in 10 sub-Saharan African countries. The goal of DREAMS is to help girls develop into **D**etermined, **R**esilient, **E**mpowered, **A**IDS-free, **M**entored, and **S**afe women. This indicator reflects program data on how many AGYW are being served in DREAMS and whether all AGYW in DREAMS have received the intended layered services/interventions to ensure that they remain HIV-free. Specifically, this indicator will measure how many AGYW enrolled in DREAMS have completed the DREAMS primary package of services/interventions, the primary package plus any secondary and/or contextual services/interventions, and how many have completed less than the primary package.

**Completed at least the DREAMS primary package of services/interventions:** Using the [DREAMS Guidance](#) and the [DREAMS Layering Guidance](#), each DREAMS country should define the primary, secondary, and contextual package of DREAMS services/interventions for each AGYW age band (10–14, 15–19, and 20–24).

- **Primary services/interventions** are defined as interventions that *all* AGYW in an age group should receive if they are enrolled in DREAMS in the country.

- **Secondary services/interventions** are needs-based interventions that are part of the DREAMS core package but may not be received by all AGYW in that age group (i.e., only AGYW who experience violence should receive post-violence care).
- **Contextual interventions** are those that are part of the DREAMS core package but cannot be linked to an individual AGYW (i.e., community mobilization).

#### Disaggregates:

1. AGYW enrolled in DREAMS that have *fully completed* at least one DREAMS service/intervention but *not* the full primary package of services/interventions
  2. AGYW enrolled in DREAMS that have *fully completed* the entire DREAMS primary package of services/interventions but have not received any services/interventions beyond the primary package
  3. AGYW enrolled in DREAMS that have *fully completed* the primary package of services/interventions *and* at least one secondary or contextual service/intervention
- **Age/Sex disaggregate:** This should represent the current age of the AGYW at the time of last service delivery or the end of the current reporting period.
    - While the DREAMS Layering Table focuses on the DREAMS target age group of 10–24-year-old AGYW, the 25–29F age band is included here to account for AGYW who were 22–24 years old when initially enrolled into DREAMS and have since aged out. DREAMS programming should not target 25–29-year-old AGYW unless explicitly approved in the country operational plan (COP).
  - **Layering of services/interventions disaggregate:** Countries should use their approved DREAMS Layering Tables to determine the makeup of the primary package of services/interventions reported in this indicator. A service should not be counted toward package completion until it is fully completed by the individual AGYW (see above).
  - **Time in DREAMS disaggregate:** the time since enrollment into DREAMS for each AGYW (e.g., 0–3 months disaggregate represents the number of AGYW who have been enrolled in DREAMS for 0–3 months).

#### Reporting

##### To be counted for this indicator the following criteria must be met:

- The individuals were AGYW between 10 and 24 years old at the time of participation in DREAMS.
- This indicator is specific to DREAMS programs in DREAMS-designated districts.
- The service/training was provided by a PCV or their counterpart in an individual or small group setting of 25 or less.
- Attendance at each session was documented by the Volunteer or their counterpart.
